Office of Religious and Independent School Supp@RISS) Mandated Services Aid (MSA) & Comprehensive Attendance Policy (CAP) Reimbursement Programs

- Purpose: The Mandated Services Aid (MSA) & Comprehensive Attendance Policy (CAP) programs provide New York State (NYS) Ingious and Independer (R&I) schools with reimbursement for some expenditures related to specific mandates
- Governance: The MSACAP program is a NYS capital funded program and administered by the New York State Education Department (NYSED) and is based on the following laws/rules/regulations:
 - 1. 8 CRRNY 3.36
 - 2. 8 CRRNY 104.1
 - 3. Section 912 of the Education Law
 - 4. Section 3204 of the Education Law
 - 5. Section 3205 of the Education Law
 - 6. 8 CRRNY 104.1(i)

Eligibility: Eligibility has been preletermined based on New York State Education Department (NYSED) data. The criteria used for preletermination include:

- 1. Open/operational during the application claim year
- 2. Religious & Independent school (nprofit or not-for-profit R&I schools only)
- 3. Provide instruction in accordance with section 3204 of the Education Law
- 4. Require students to attend full time instruction according to section 3205 of the Education Law (kindergarten through twelfth grade, only)
- 5. Religious and Independent Schools (nporofit or not-for-profit schools only). 853 or Approved Special Education Schools are ineligible.
- 6. Not be the recipients on3. (o)2 (ug) 145.98 435.6 14.64 re f* BT 0.267001 Tc 0.2(o)3

9. Filed a timely BEDS report with NYS EDfise of Information and Reporting Services (IRS) with enrollment data for the 202-2024 School Year (SY). For the purposes of this program, the SY is defined as July June 30.
